Note on wounding an animal: An animal wounded is an animal killed. We encourage clients to take only those shots they are sure of. We respect the game and its precious value on this earth. If a client wounds an animal and it escapes, hunter will be allowed to search for it until found or the hunt is over.

Clients should not harvest any game without the presence of guide.

Booking

DEPOSITS AND RESERVATIONS:

Current season deposit: A 50% deposit is required to book the particular dates of the hunt you select. Payments may be made by check, credit card (MasterCard or VISA), or by wire transfer. For wire information, please call or email us.

Future season deposit: Hunts booked over 1 year in advance may be held with a 25% deposit with remainder of deposit due February 1 of hunt year. This down payment will reserve any hunt, however, it does not guarantee this season's price. Partial payments apply toward the required 50% down payment and give you the right for first refusal. We hold the hunt for you, therefore, the deposit is nonrefundable. We will hold the space you request for ten days in anticipation of deposit.

Final Payment: Final payment is due 60 days prior to arrival date and can be made in cash, bank/cashiers check, traveler's checks, credit card, or wire transfer. All monies are U.S. funds.

Deposits are a commitment to the hunt, both on the part of the outfitter and the hunter. They are not refundable, nor are they transferable unless you can provide another approved hunter to take your place.

Cancellation and Trip Insurance: Should you find it necessary to cancel your trip, deposit payments are 50% refundable up to 60 days prior to arrival date, and if your cancelled hunt is rebooked a fee of \$500 will be charged. No refunds will be made within 60 days of your arrival date. However, clients may rebook for the following season for 15% fee plus the difference in future season price. We recommend trip cancellation insurance to protect your investment, available at most travel agencies or check with your local insurance companies.
