Sitka Black-tailed Deer Hunt Gear List

This is not an all inclusive list, it is a reference to help determine the things you may need in the field. Depend on your type of hunt, location, allowable weight, and personal comfort you may want to add or remove for your personal comfort.

Rifle, Archery, Alaska Hunting License, Locking-tags, and Harvest Tickets:			
	Rifle and Scope: For Sitka Black-tailed Deer, recommended calibers are .270wsm, .300 Win Mag. Two boxes of ammo, 200 - 250 gr triple shock. Archery bow equipment. Otis tactical gun cleaning kit and scope cleaning cloth, and ear plugs. Hard case for rifle/bow on commercial airline travel.		
Waterfowl and/or Fishing (Optional/Daily Rate):			
	State Waterfowl Stamp and Federal Migratory Bird Hunting and Conservation Stamp, if applicable. Alaska Sport Fishing License (7-day), if applicable. King stamp, if targeting winter Kings.		
Back Pack Gear and Sleeping System:			
	Sleeping bag w/sack (Lightweight) rated for 0 degrees and small pillow. Frame Pack or Internal Frame Pack. Barney's Pack's, KUIU Ultra 7000, Glacier backpack, or lightweight. Kifaru. Pack Rain Cover. Headlamp and/or small flashlight with extra batteries. Petzl Myo or FEnix HP15. Trekking Poles/Tripod Shooting. Leki. Water-proof matches or lighter. 2-Quart water bottles. Waterproof bags, compression stuff sacks/bags, (2-small, 2-medium, 2-large). Zip Top, Sea to Summi

		1- small tarp, (Optional).
		Wyoming bone saw (blades for bone and wood).

Salt for cape/trophy.
Game bags (2 bags for deer and 1 bag for cape).
Plastic bag, contractor, 3-mil. (2).
2-books for bad weather days.
Bank checks, cashiers check, or cash.

Packing: Pack all hunting gear in waterproof bags, except backpack and rifle (soft case) or bow. Gear is hand carried on air charter flights or boats. Air charter weight limit: passenger, 100 lbs of gear, and rifle or bow. Transporter has meat boxes/tape for fee. Also, Transporter is a "known shipper" to use at Kodiak cargo/freight.

Communication: Use Garmin InReach and/or satellite phone for emergencies. They may be purchased or rented.

Pre-Purchased Alaska Hunting License, Locking Tags, and Harvest Tickets: Pre-purchase Alaska hunting license and big game locking-tags online at ADF&G website. Besides license(s) and tags, clients are required to have harvest tickets/permit for each specie their hunting before going into the field. No fees required for permits or harvest tickets.

Weather: Temperatures range from mid-30's to mid-40's, strong winds, rain, and possible snow.

Big Game Carcass Weight: Sitka Black-tailed Deer: 120 lbs;
